valid NAVIGA NS and NSS rulebooks

Standard Categories:	F2-A, F2-B, F2-C, F4-A, F4-B, F4-C, F-DS, F6, F7, NSS-A, NSS-B, NSS-C, NSS-D, F-S Junior and senior in the all categories
Extra Categories:	Night Run, Ladies Regatta In extra categories there are no building inspection, one run only, own ship model is not required. Awards: Cup, medal, certificate.
Junior age group:	For participants under the age of 19.
Number of participants:	National teams can appoint five competitors per class. In addition to five competitors the titleholder can be appointed in every class. <u>Because this is an open championship, competitors from non-member countries are also welcomed. Please contact the organizers!</u>
Evaluation and awards:	In every category, the winner receives the official "World Champion" title, and his country's national anthem will be played in his honour. The first three competitors in a category receive a medal and a certificate. Other participants also receive a certificate.
Registration fee for standard categories:	Senior: 40.0 EUR per category per competitor, Junior: 20.0 EUR per category per competitor. On the spot 50.0 EUR per category per competitor
Registration fee for extra categories:	Uniformly, 20.0 EUR per category per competitor
Banquet:	40.0 EUR per person.
Protest fee:	According to current rules 20.0 EUR per occasion.
Nomination deadline:	May 31, 2024 in e-mail.
Rules of nomination:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The official registration can occur only through the national organisation.</li> <li>2. For every participant a separate registration must be filled</li> <li>3. Additionally the team leader must provide a full list of the participants in his team.</li> <li>4. Every registration must be stamped and signed by the national federation.</li> <li>5. No other forms of registrations are allowed.</li> </ol>

Rules of payment: After receiving the registration form by email, the organizers will send back the bank details for the payment.

On the spot registration fee is higher!  
The final appointment, for the transfer of all fees is the 15th of June, 2024

Required documents: Passport, Visa and other identity documents.  
Valid insurance for the full duration of the competition.

Frequency bands: 27 MHz, 40 MHz, 2.4 GHz

Channels: 27 MHz: 26.995 ; 27.045 ; 27.095 ; 27.145 ; 27.195 MHz  
40 MHz: 40.665 ; 40.675 ; 40.685 ; 40.695 MHz  
2.4 GHz

National flags and anthems: Every national association must provide 3 national flags (100x150 cm.), and their national anthem on CD. These will be returned to the team leader after the closing ceremony.

Registration on the spot: 1. The team leaders register the competitors in their team.  
2. The competitors register their models with names of the models and frequencies, and then a frequency check will be performed.  
If changes are made to the following data:

- Participant
- Class
- Model
- Frequency change

a fee of 10.0 EUR must be paid for every change.
